.22 Junior League Rules and Guidelines
2017

Age Requirements:

- Competitors may be: 7-15 Years old at time of registration.
- A signed waiver will be required.
- General Requirements
- Competitors must have parental consent
- Parent must accompany competitors at time of registration
- It will be a 2 week league meeting Sunday Mornings at 10:00 AM
- The league will attempt to accommodate schedule conflicts, make-ups are allowed.
- **Dates: Sunday, July 9th and 15th**
- The winner will be determined by the total accumulative score in each class
- Ties will be decided by total number of bull's eyes (x's), if still tied, it will be determined by a shoot off
- Prizes for Top Shooters will be awarded
- All participants will receive Sportsman's club T-shirts
- Safety glasses and ear plugs are required
- Safety on the range is of utmost importance, unsafe actions will not be tolerated and will be grounds for disqualification or removal of the participant, instructors will provide assistance and participants will follow directions immediately or be asked to not participate.
- No fees will be charged. Members and supporters of NBSC are sponsoring the event.
- Make up for weeks missed can be arranged in advance.

Equipment:

- .22 Long Rifles with open sights will be used, scoped rifles may be allowed for practice.
- Participants may provide their own rifle or use a rifle provided at the range
- Instructors will provide ammunition, and safety equipment
- Shooting style will vary from week to week.
- Targets will vary depending on weekly competition.

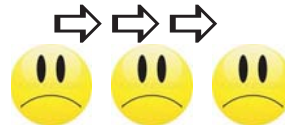

Range News

Pistol Range Orientations

Any Member that has not maintained continuous Membership or the continuous payment of the Range Maintenance Fee (RMF) must re-take the Orientation when reactivating same to continue with the use of the Pistol Range.

The Member when returning, will be considered a new member and not a renewing member. The reason for this, is that over time the Orientation has changed and been updated.

Guest Policy:

1. Effective January 1, 2014 there is a \$10/hour with a \$10 minimum charge for "guest" shooters on the 50 Meter Range. Club Members are responsible for collecting the fee and completing the payment envelopes which are located in the "sign-in" mail box. The Pay envelope should be deposited in the slot near the "sign-in" mailbox.
2. Guests are limited to no more than two per Club Member, with only one at a time on the line shooting. Members are to supervise their guests while those guests are shooting. A Range Safety Officer must be present and supervising to grant an exception to this policy.
3. Members are responsible for the actions and safe conduct of their guests.

Policy for Unescorted Youth.

1. Youth under 16 years of age may not be on the 50 Meter Range unescorted and unsupervised. A parent or other adult Club Member must be present at all times within visual range.
2. Youth 16 years to 18 years of age, may use the 50 Meter Range unescorted provided that they have in their possession a current Family Membership Card. Note: individuals 18 years of age or older must have their own Membership.
3. The Youth must have attended a 50 Meter Range Orientation with a parent or legal guardian. Unescorted Youth must abide by section C-8. No Handguns are allowed for unescorted youth. Youth bringing a guest (one) must abide by section E-1.

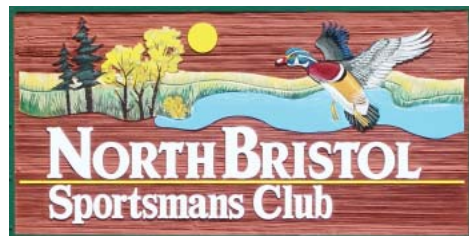
