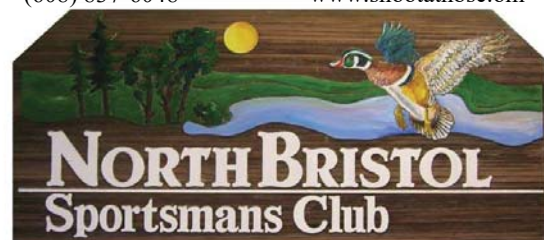

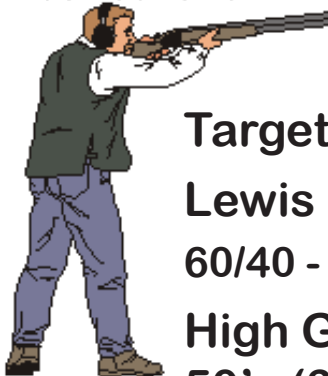

## The following is a review of the Pistol Range Orientation

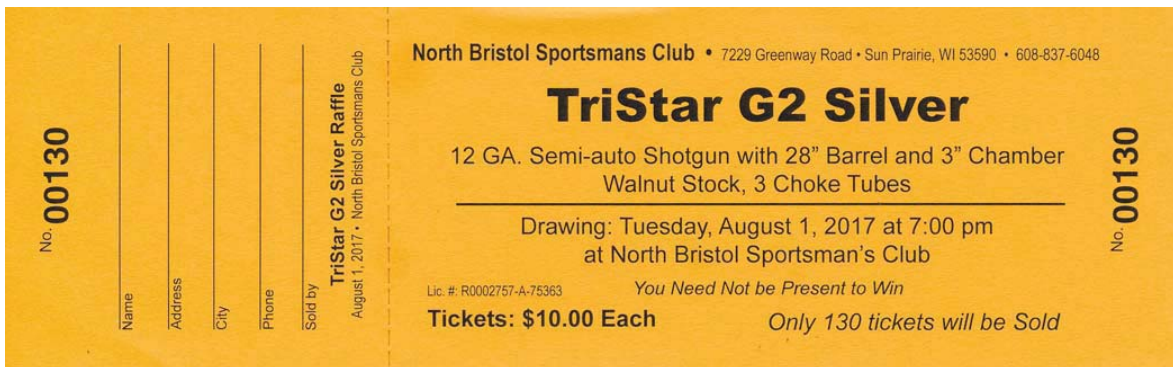
### Firearm Safety:

1. Eye and hearing protection is mandatory for all persons in the shooting area, when the range is "hot" and shooting is occurring. Hearing protection is also required in the observation area when the range is "hot". Hearing aids turned down or off are not valid hearing protection.
2. Casing and uncasing guns is to be only during a "hot" range.
3. No handling of guns during a "Cold" range, except magazines can be reloaded.
4. Firearms are to be pointed in a safe direction at all times and unloaded unless at the firing line with the muzzle pointed down range when the range is "hot". There is no "Dry Fire" practice while the range is "Cold"
5. Loaded guns are to be pointed down range at all times. Note: No horizontal shoulder holsters should be used No loaded firearms to be worn in a holster, unless it is being carried concealed and not visible or not used on the range.
6. Know your target and beyond. Note: Ensure that all rounds impact into the rear berm. Avoid ground hits-they likely will become a ricochets or strike baffles or support structures.
7. When not in use, all firearms are to be unloaded with the action open and placed on a bench or table and pointed down range.
8. Communicate with all other shooters on the shooting line when the range is cold and going down range.
9. No handling of firearms while anyone is forward of the firing line. Do not handle firearms belonging to others without permission
10. Alcohol in any form is not permitted on the range. Anyone appearing to be under the influence of alcohol or other intoxicants will be asked to leave.
11. Loud or rowdy behavior is not permitted. Children must be under adult supervision.
12. Safety is your responsibility. Address any safety issue you may witness. Gross violations should be reported to a Range Safety Officer, a club officer, or a club Board member.

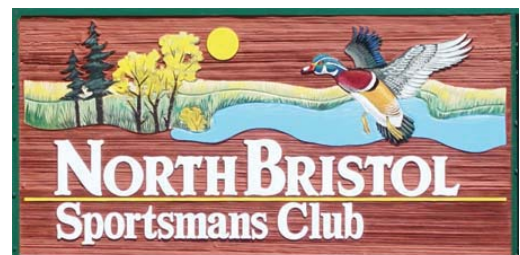

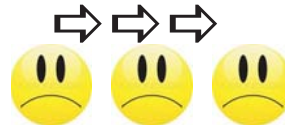

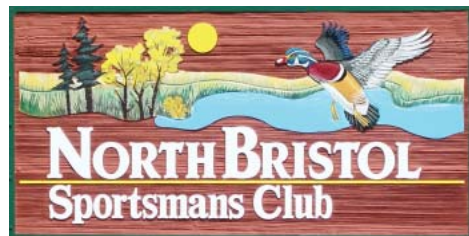
