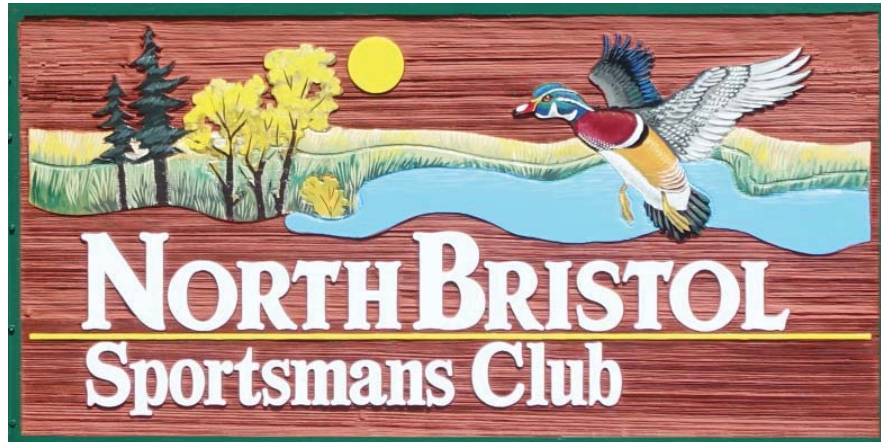

Membership cards must be available on request to validate membership status. Membership status can be verified in the club house using the member roster kept behind the bar.

Shooting from the shooting line only. Eye and ear protection required on all ranges.

All firearms shall be pointed downrange or placed in a gun rack and have empty chambers, unless being used, at all times.

No shotshells may be used that have shot larger than #7.5's on the trap and skeet ranges.

No alcohol allowed on any range, shooters under the influence of alcohol may be asked to leave the range and/or club house.

Please keep the range safe and clean. Notify club manager of any misuse or damage.

Access to the handgun range is only through the gate. All shooting shall be from the firing line.

**You must sign-in every time you use the hand gun range. No centerfire rifles on the pistol range.**

**Firearm shooting hours are from 9:00am to sunset, except during league shooting.**

I acknowledge that violating any of the above rules could result in loss or suspension of membership, suspension from league (w/o reimbursement) and/or suspension of future use. I acknowledge that I am financially responsible for any damage that I or any family members cause, by action or negligence to the club grounds, equipment or neighboring property. I, also, release the NBSC from any liabilities incurred by me or mine.

**Policy for Unescorted Youth on the 50  
Meter Range  
Approved by the NBSC Board on March  
17, 2009**

Youth under 16 years of age may not be on the 50 meter range unescorted. A parent or other adult Club Member must be present at all times.

Youth 16 years of age to under 18 years of age may use the 50 Meter range unescorted, provided they possess their own membership card under a current NBSC Family Membership.

The youth must have attended a 50 meter Range Safety and Orientation Session with a parent or legal guardian. Unescorted youth range use is restricted to BB or pellet rifles; rimfire rifles; muzzle loading rifles; and shotguns for patterning and sight-in only – no handguns.

At 18 years of age, all persons must apply for their own NBSC membership.

## Announcement

The Board of Directors Recently completed a number of meetings to discuss and finalize costs and Pricing for 2017. Some of the changes approved at these meetings, include 5 Stand operation and pricing, increase in non member Trap Fees, Raising the Range Maintenance Fee (RMF) for the single projectile ranges to \$ 20.00 and some changes to membership fees for partial year dues, and Life Membership requirements. We also eliminated gratis memberships to active Board members.

Some of the factors that guided these policies include, reduced Fund Raising income from Raffle sales and Fall Shoot, increased Maintenance requirements for the Rifle and Pistol Range, fewer volunteers participating in work days and projects, increasing outside vendor expenses annually. And just plain higher prices on everything we need. We continue to try to control costs and needs to offer members and exceptional value to become and participate in activities at the club. The decisions were not arrived at randomly, but we hope struck a balance with everything considered to best serve the members and the interest and survival of the club. Feel free to discuss any concerns with the board members, or better yet, come on out to the Monthly meetings and help guide the clubs decisions.



# Winter/Spring League Monday Night January 16, 2017

The Winter/Spring leagues from the past will be combined into one 10-week season, preceded by a practice/registration night. The league will be extended if there are any complete cancellations because of weather.

Practice/Registration will be Monday night, January 16th, regular season will start January 23rd and end on March 27th, barring any weather cancellations..

Fees will be similar to the summer leagues, \$10 - member, \$13 - non-member. Sponsor fee will be \$10 per person, all sponsor fees will be returned as prize money. Payouts will be determined using 'Lewis Class'. Fun night has not been determined, yet.

### **We would like to review a few items.**

The Range is open from 9:00 am to dusk daily (for those that are current in their Range Maintenance Fee (RMF) and have completed the Orientation), unless the range is closed for special events or leased out.

Always check the newsletter and our website.

When using the Range, please close the gates behind you unless the Rifle Range is open. The last member out should close and lock the gate, again unless the Rifle Range is open. Please do not leave the Range open just because the Club is open.

When you sign in, remember it is one name per line for each visitor to the range. We use the information on the sign-in sheets for a contract with the DNR.

If you have a gun for protection, remember: practice, practice, practice. Reasons for practice is to hit what you aim at and know where the safety is, in case you need your gun in a hurry

## *Interested in becoming a Range Safety Officer?*

We have an ongoing need for RSOs on the rifle range and, soon, the pistol range. NRA certification requires a one day class and, for NBSC, an RSO specific range orientation. ## Monthly Drawing

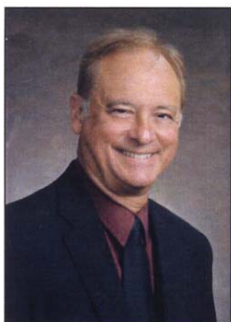
