(Daily Lewis Paid 4 Classes, 60/40 High Gun)

(Lucky number - 1 winner)

Final Jackpot Purse: \$2,845.50 - with 27 Qualified as of 1/17/18

- To qualify for the purse, a shooter must have shot the program a total of 10 times prior to the Final Jackpot
- Final Jackpot purse will be paid out 6 classes, One money/Ties divide
- Only the first score is eligible for the "Final Jackpot Purse"

You may shoot the Final Jackpot more than once, but only the first score will be eligible for the Final Jackpot purse. Entry fee is \$31.00 (includes \$10.00 lewis & Lucky Number) after your first score.
